DOWNTOWN BRIDGEPORT: A MIXED-USE COMMUNITY

Downtown Bridgeport is a friendly, eclectic business and residential community flourishing at the intersection of commerce, community, and culture.

250,000 vehicles pass through Bridgeport everyday. Downtown is proximate to major highways and provides extensive public transportation infrastructure, including train, bus, and ferry service.

Downtown Bridgeport is home to the Read's Artspace artists residence, premier contemporary galleries like BPT Creates, City Lights, and Ursa; and performing arts spaces such as the Bijou Theatre, Downtown Cabaret, and Stress Factory Comedy Club.

The city is regenerating and building on its history of industry and innovation with the many arts, creative, and nightlife or entertainment businesses locating here contributing to and creating its culture.

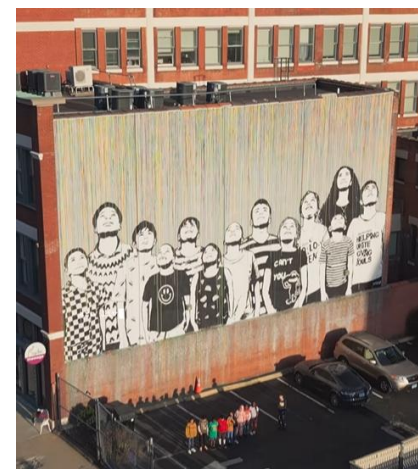
DOWNTOWN BRIDGEPORT: A COMMUNITY TO CREATE

The Bridgeport DSSD is also powered by program committees: Physical Conditions, Public Safety, and Special Events + Marketing.

The Operations Team consists of DSSD President + CEO Lauren Coakley Vincent, Downtown Ambassador Operations Manager Charles Suarez-Penn, and Creative Director Marcella Kovac.

Partnerships are critical to the DSSD’s daily functioning, including the participation of residents, business owners, and cultural, educational anchor institutions.

Prospective Commissioners must be able to meet these qualifications:

- Own property or hold a formal, written lease within the boundaries of the DSSD: Pequonnock River across to Route 8, and East Washington Avenue down to Interstate 95.
- Be able to attend board meetings on the second Wednesday at 4:00 p.m.

To be included in the annual meeting ballot, applicants must fill out the nomination form with your name, a brief bio, lease verification, and a statement of interest in serving the neighborhood.

Key dates!

- February 2, 2026: Nomination form opens
- February and March 11, 2026: Board of Commissioners meetings
- April 3, 2026: Nomination form closes
- May 13, 2026: DSSD Annual Meeting
